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THE FOLLOWING NAMES WERE COPIED FROM AN OLD BUTTE COUNTY COURT-HOUSE RECORD BOOK HOUSED IN THE MERIAM LIBRARY, CHICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

A newspaper article attached to the inside cover of this old book stated: "HONORING THE DEAD; PROVISIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNMENT TO PERPETUATE THE MEMORY OF SOLDIERS. There is a law in this state which says that every old soldier is entitled to a decent burial, and the sum of \$50 is apportioned therefore. In connection with this the United States Government furnishes a marble slab to mark the place of interment."
