The Folks at FamilySearch have created assorted types of Collections of Records from the 1950 Census. One such is "Hospitals and Institutions" These are interesting records. If you have been unable to find an Ancestor using traditional methods, these records could be helpful

I host Counties in 6 States: Alaska ~ California ~ Minnesota ~ Missouri ~ New York ~ Oregon. The indexes that have been created include the Film Number, Location of the Census and the ED and Description. The Descriptions contain the name of the Hospital or Institution.

The Film Numbers are linked to the FS Historical Images section of FamilySearch. To save time once the Indexes were completed, I have formatted all 6 States into one fully seachable PDF. Use CTRL-F to search, entering either a location or Name of an Institution or Hospital. If you do not have an account, please do sign up, it is free.

Genealogical Committee of the LDS Church

Years ago [mid 1950's], the Genealogical Committee of the L.D.S. Church went about the Countryside recording and compiling information from local Cemeteries. They then typed up their findings. Later, the FHL[Genealogical Society] filmed the records. For the most part, the records were hand written on preprinted forms. California State Journal of Medicine

The California and American Medical Association began publishing Journals early in the 20th Century.

They contain a wealth of information which includes all sorts of Articles on Disease, Surgeries, and much more.

Along with the Medical portion of the Journal are Memorials, Obituaries and Death Notices.

Additionally, there is a Section called the "Medical Board of Examiners" which tracks Crime within the Medical Community.

So Stay tuned, I will be adding information formatted into Searchable pdf files, beginning with 1903.

In July of 1946, The California and Western Medical Magazine changed it's name to "California Medicine The Journal of Western Medicine"
