

EARLY CHURCH RECORDS: ST. JAMES EPISCOPAL CHURCH, FRESNO, CALIFORNIA

A few years ago I received permission to copy from the surname list in an old record book from the archives of St. James Episcopal Cathedral in Fresno. This book contains the names of the first members of the parish dating from its beginning in 1879. Soon names from the list became families, a man and his wife with several children; a man alone establishing himself in a pioneer area; and sometimes a woman with her children facing life by herself. All were here at that time at least, and each participated in his own way to create a town and build a church.

In September of 1879 the Rev. Mr. D. O. Kelly "was charged with the Mission District of San Joaquin extending from Stanislaus to Kern County, inclusive." This was an extensive territory of dry plains, low foothills and swampy river bottom lands, with few roads and fewer settlements. Evidently Mr. Kelly and his wife Annie, aged 25, had two children aged 4 and 2½ years, and 5 sons all listed as "infants". I have not been able to obtain further information on the children.

In 1879 "St. James Mission, Fresno" was duly organized with W.D. Tupper, Warden; A.L. Hoffman, Treasurer and E. Hall, Clerk. Mr. Kelly was "Missionary in Charge." Early in 1881 "the present church building and parsonage" were erected and occupied... for some time in an unfinished condition." On Dec. 7, 1884 the church was consecrated. St. James Parish was duly organized April 1, 1888 and the Rev. Mr. Kelly became the Rector.

"On Easter Monday, April 7, 1890, the following vestrymen were elected: W.A. Gilmour, Dr. H. St. George Hopkins (one of Fresno's pioneer physicians and a veteran of the Confederate army), Wm. G. Urledge, George E. Grimes, E.M. Drury and Wm. P. Spratt. At this time Mrs. Andrus, wife of the church treasurer George H. Andrus, was superintendent of the Sunday School. Her assistant teachers were: Mrs. Kelly, Mrs. Agnes M. Parson, Mrs. Louise Carnahan, Mrs. Emma R. Foster, Mrs. Eames and Mrs. Mabel Simmons. Three Guilds were also organized: St. James Guild, St. Agnes Guild and the Children's Guild and the St. Andrews Brotherhood, St. James Chapter was begun. In 1891 Mr. Kelly resigned his rectorship and moved to Merced and at this time, or early in 1892, the Rev. Mr. Wm. Lucas became Rector.

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SAND MOUNTAIN

A little-known battle of the Civil War was that of Sand Mountain during April of 1863 between the forces of Colonel Abel D. Streight and the "Wizard of the Saddle", Brigadier General Nathan Bedford Forrest. Forrest intercepted Streight quite by accident as the Northern troops proceeded on their 1000 mile raid on the Confederate railroads at Rome, Georgia, and defeated the shrewd Streight by both skill and a ruse in this sparsely settled northeastern corner of Alabama. The exact location of the battlefield is not now known, but is guessed at, aided by the U.S. Geological Survey map which shows a site marked "Battleground" near Alabama State Highway 157, 14 miles northeast of Cullman and 7 miles southeast of Falkville. Researchers feel that it is likely that this is the site of the Battle of Sand Mountain.
