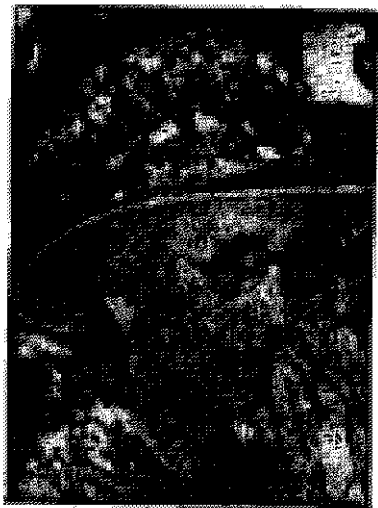

In August 1942, when working as a mechanic in the Army Air Forces in Mindanao, The Philippines, he was taken prisoner and remained in Japanese hands for 2½ years.

During the transfer of 750 prisoners in September 1944 from one prison camp to another, an American torpedo struck, and the prisoners took the opportunity to escape. The Japanese tossed hand grenades and fired machine guns at the fleeing Americans, and only 82 of them, including Mr. Granz, survived a two-mile swim to a nearby island. They were picked up by an American ship and repatriated.

Mr. Granz attained the rank of sergeant. In later years he was adjutant-secretary of the Fresno chapter of American Ex-Prisoners of War.

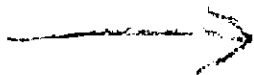
