2 persons killed in auto crashes

A 74-year-old Easton man and a 22-year-old Sanger woman died of injuries they suffered this weekend in separate automobile accidents.

Hans Ostergard was killed Sunday after he walked into the intersection of Jefferson Avenue and Highway 41 and was hit by a car, which sped away, the California Highway Patrol reported.

He was carrying a white cane when he was struck by the late-model sedan, investigators said. Further information was not released by authorities.

The accident occurred about 3:15 p.m., and officers said they did not know why the man was in the roadway.

Yamamoto's vehicle was struck by an automobile driven by Matthew Stewart, 36, of Fresno, which was westbound on Highway 168. Officers described road conditions as "icy" at the time of the accident.

Ogawa was flown to the St. Agnes Medical Center by its rescue helicopter.

Investigations of both accidents are continuing, a CHP spokeswoman said.

MADERA (AP) — Attorneys in the Superior Court murder trial of a Fresno man went through 94 prospective jurors before seating a panel of eight men and four women.

Both the district attorney and public defender exhausted almost all of their challenges during two days of jury selection in the trial of Terry Wade Adams, 43.

Adams is accused in the death of Norman Edward Brum, 37, of Madera, who was beaten unconscious and thrown into the San Joaquin River on July 3.

Public Defender Lester Gendron said Tuesday there was no particular reason for the prolonged review of potential jurors in the trial that is expected to last a week.

A few relatives and friends of police officers were dismissed, but otherwise the excused panelists fell into no categories, he said.

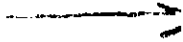
