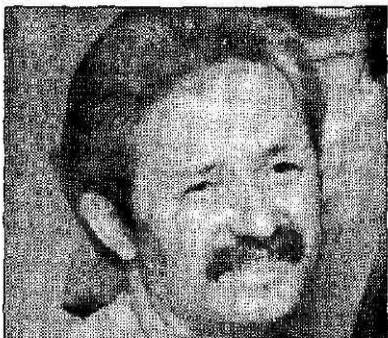
A **Fresno** man drowned early Tuesday after falling into the San Joaquin River while hunting for frogs.

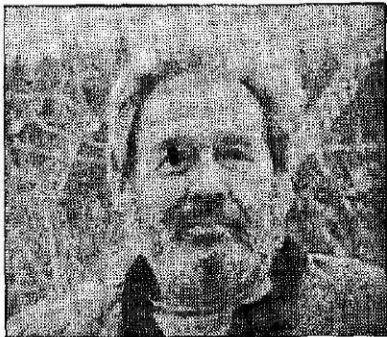
