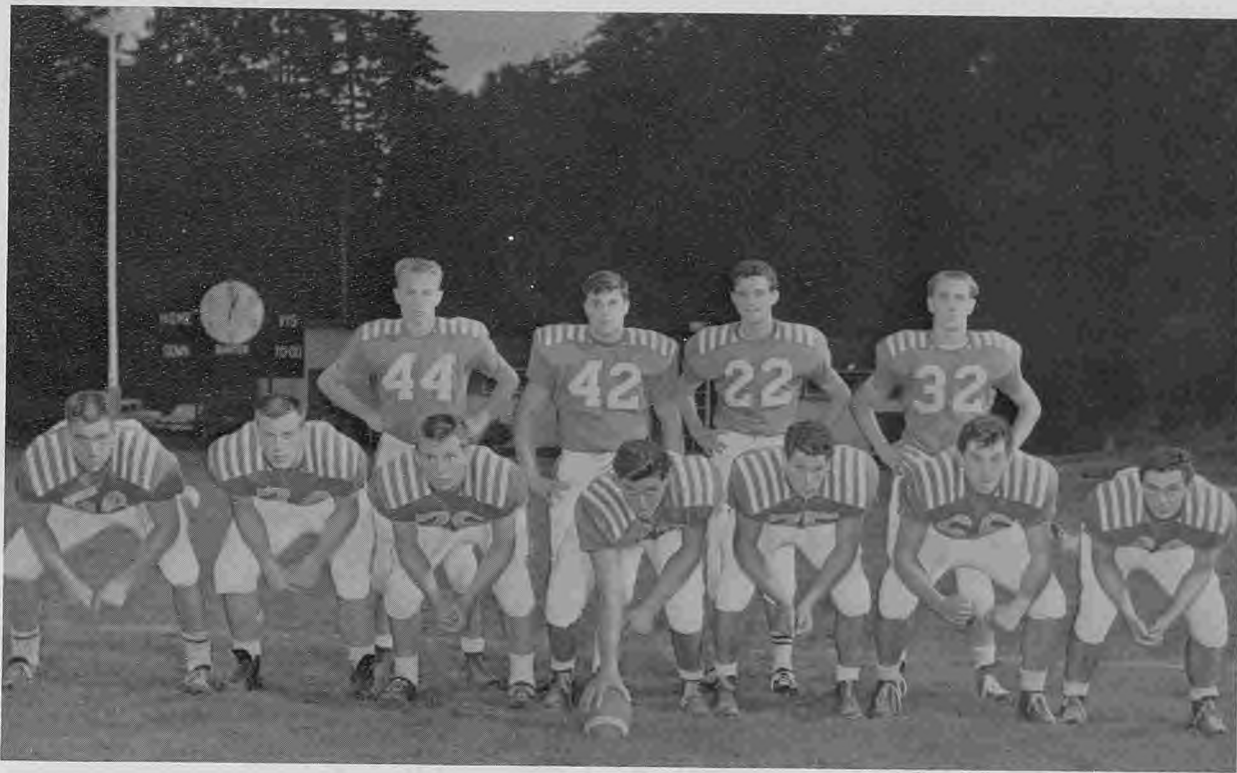

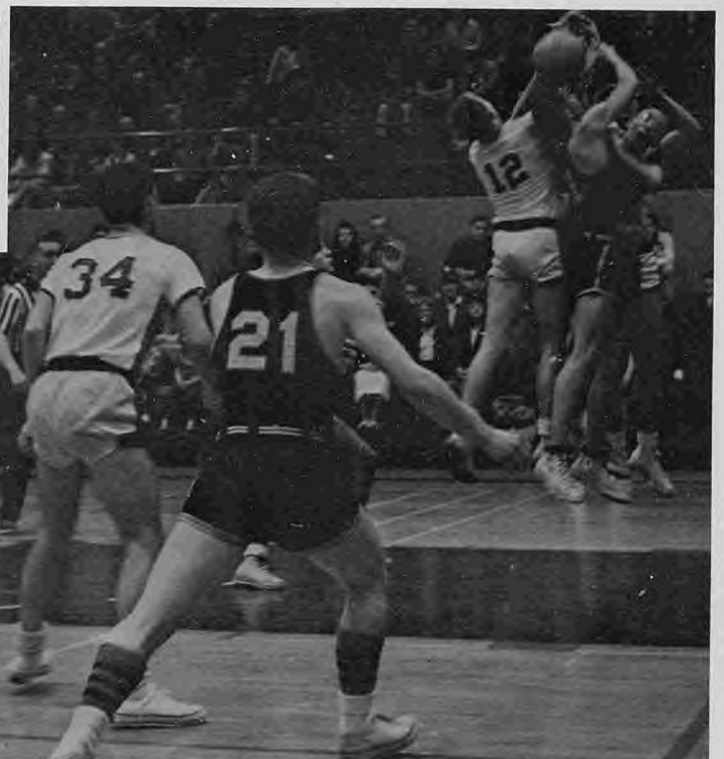

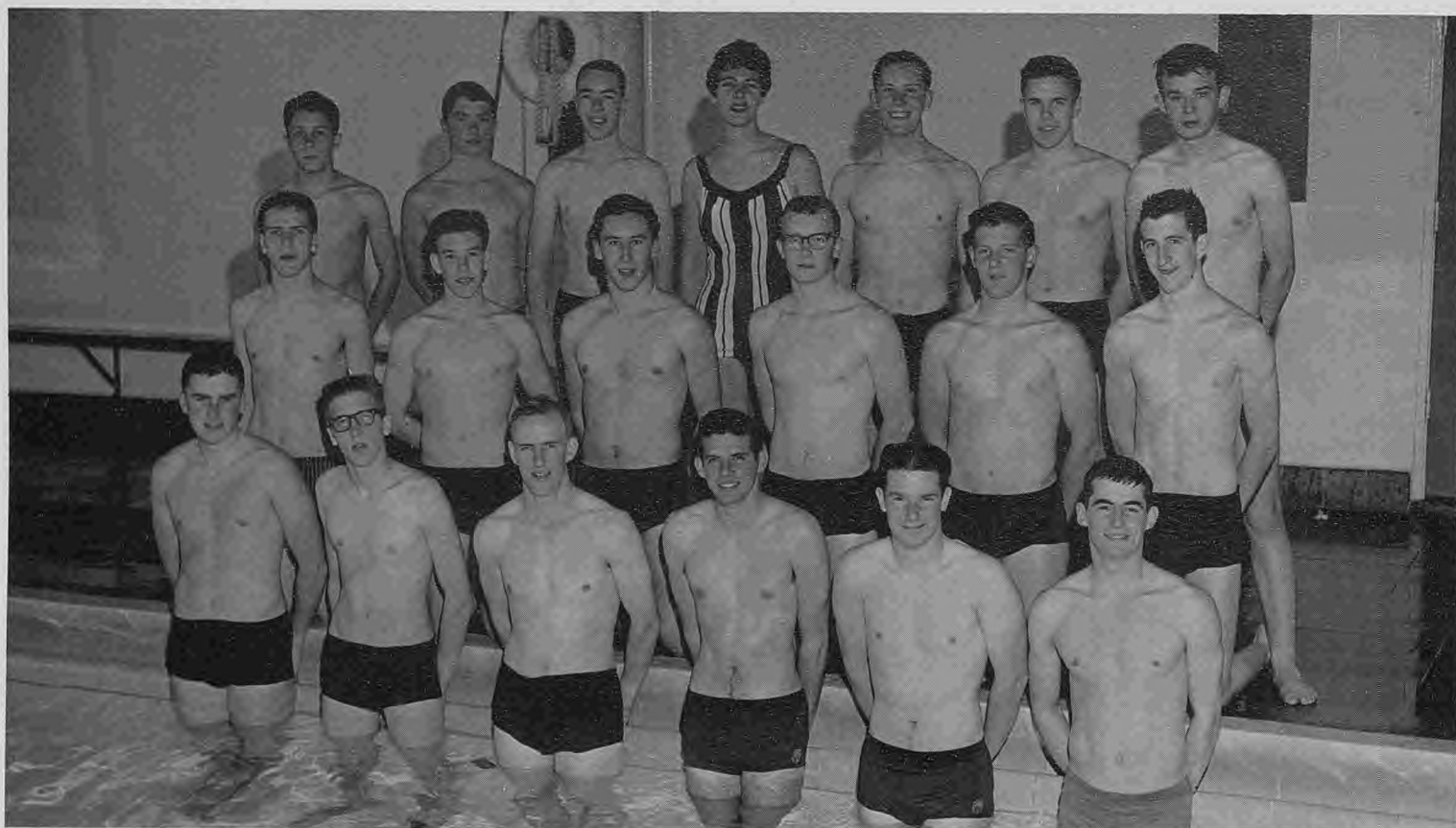

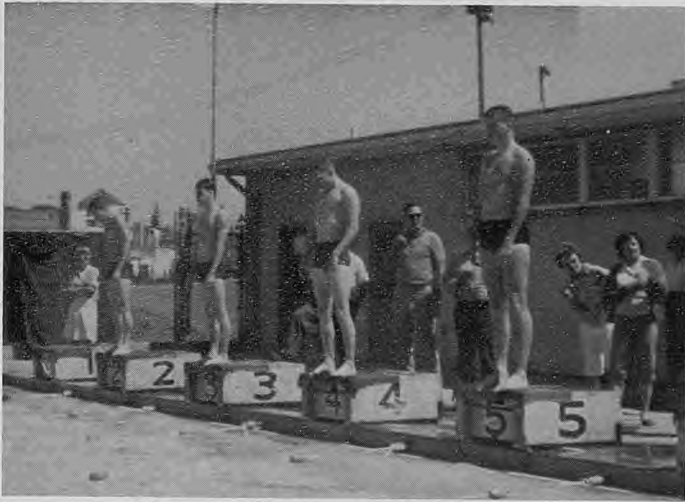

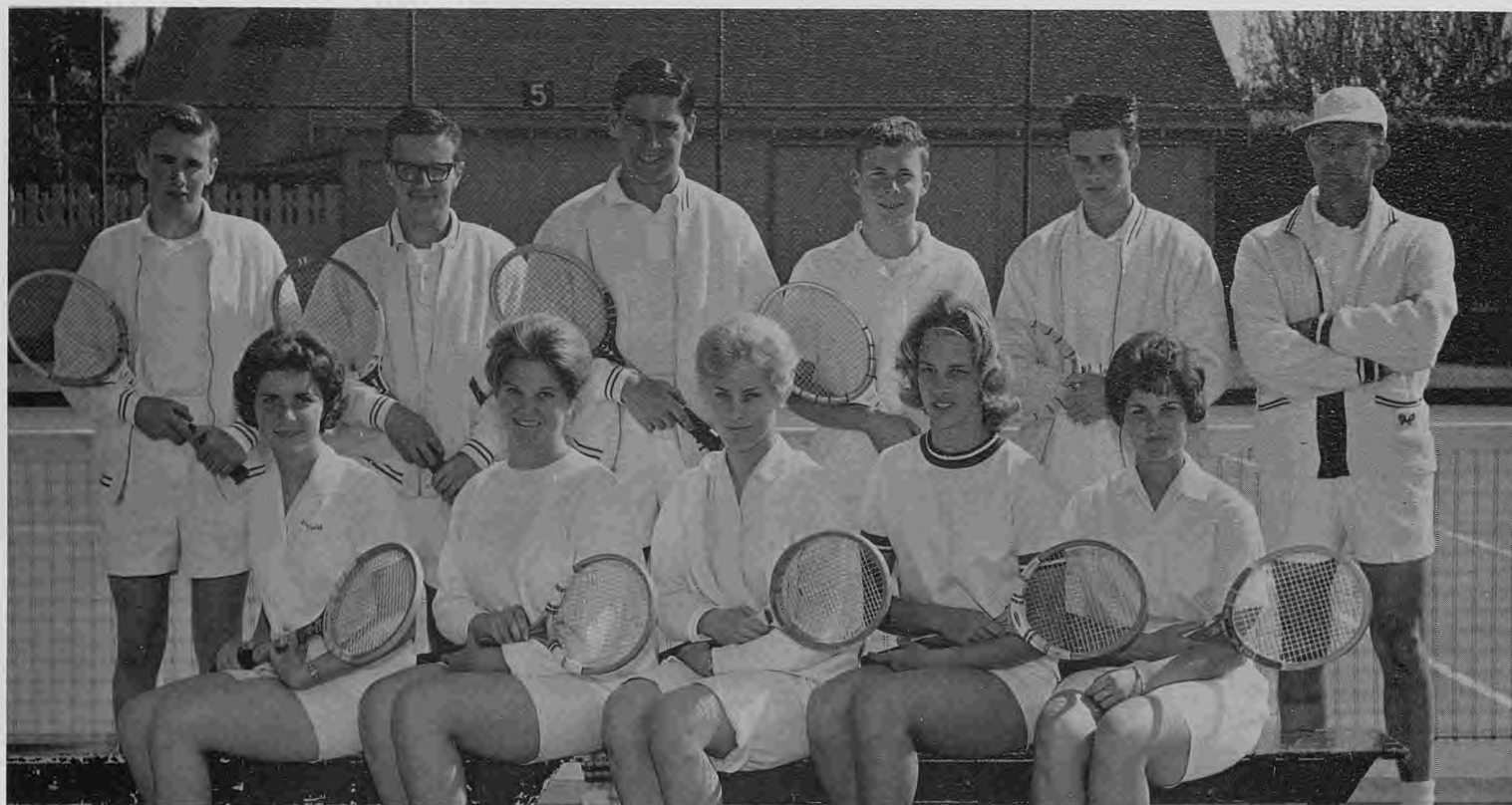

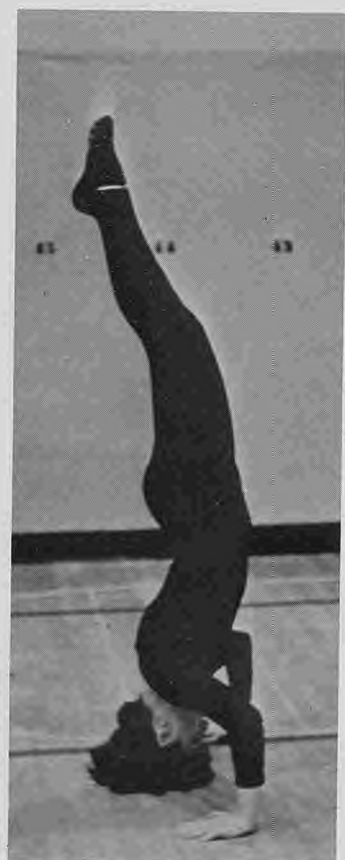

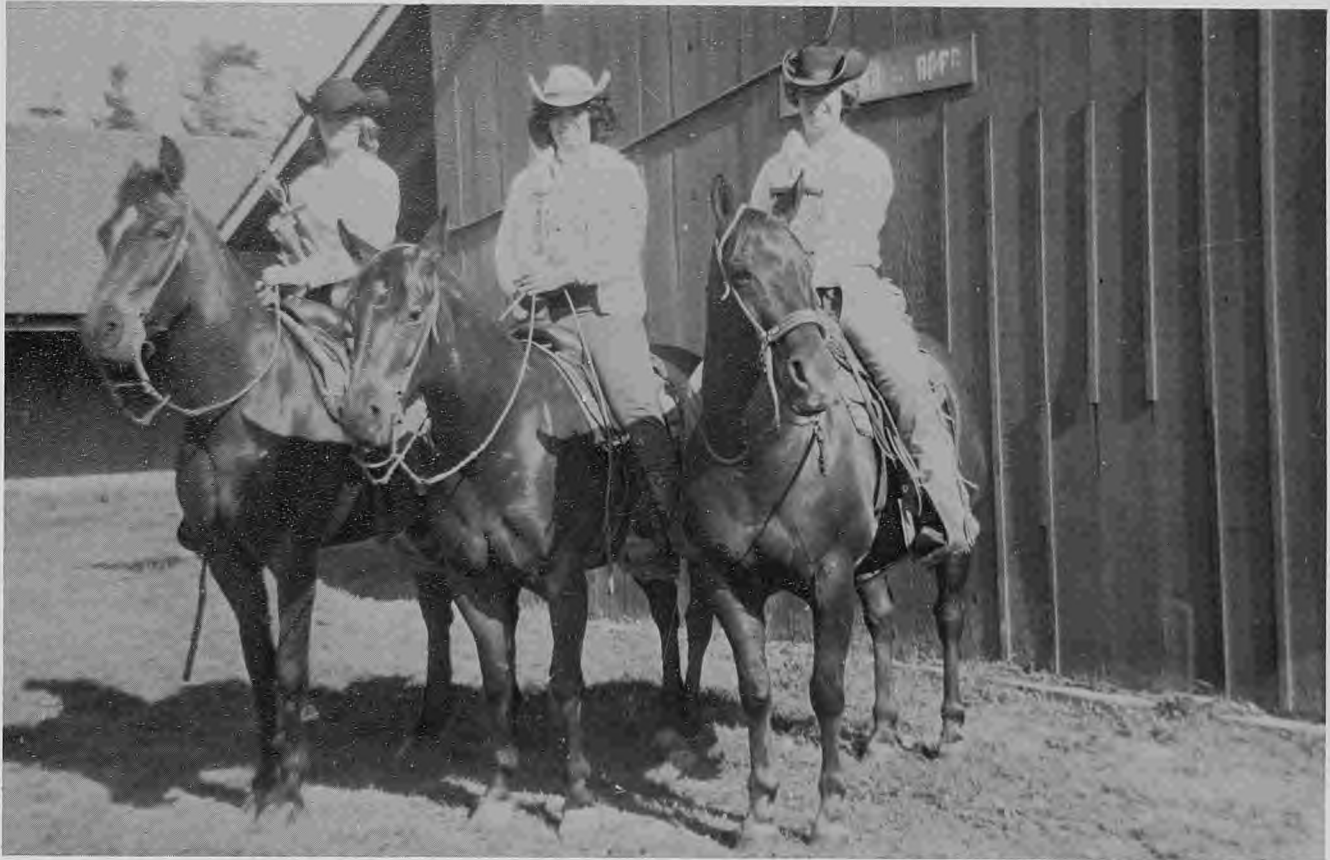


Linda Kavich shows how a "scale" is done on the balance beam.

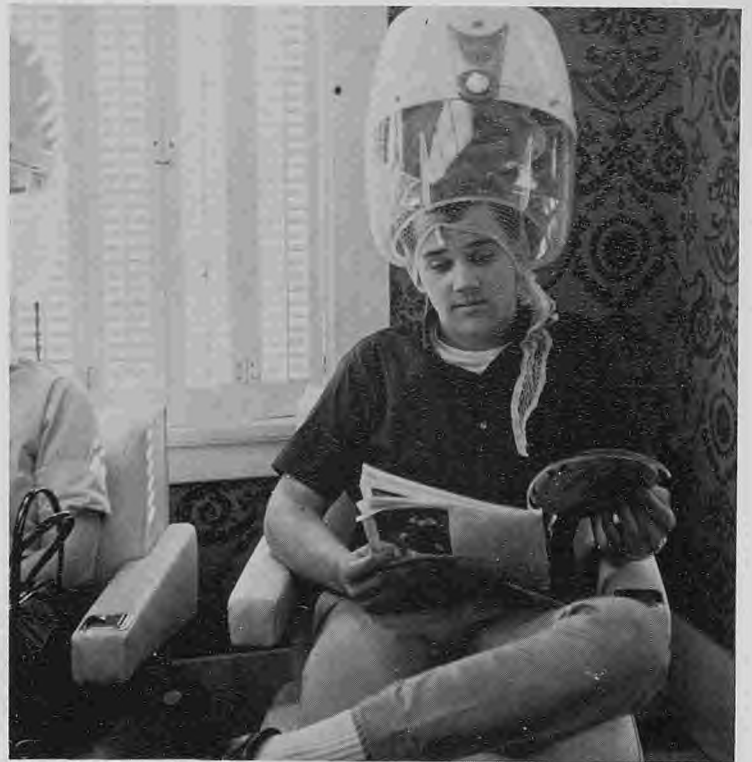

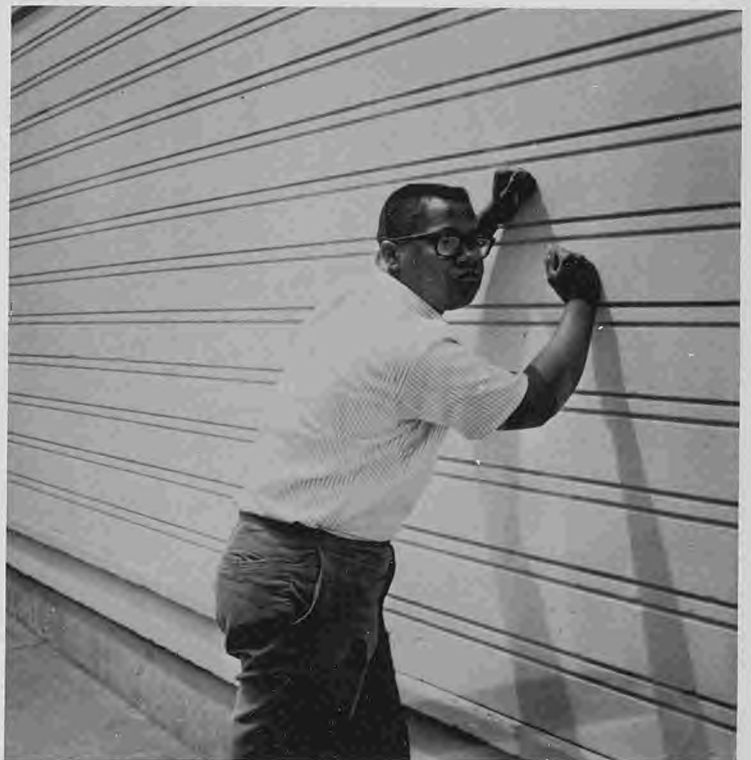

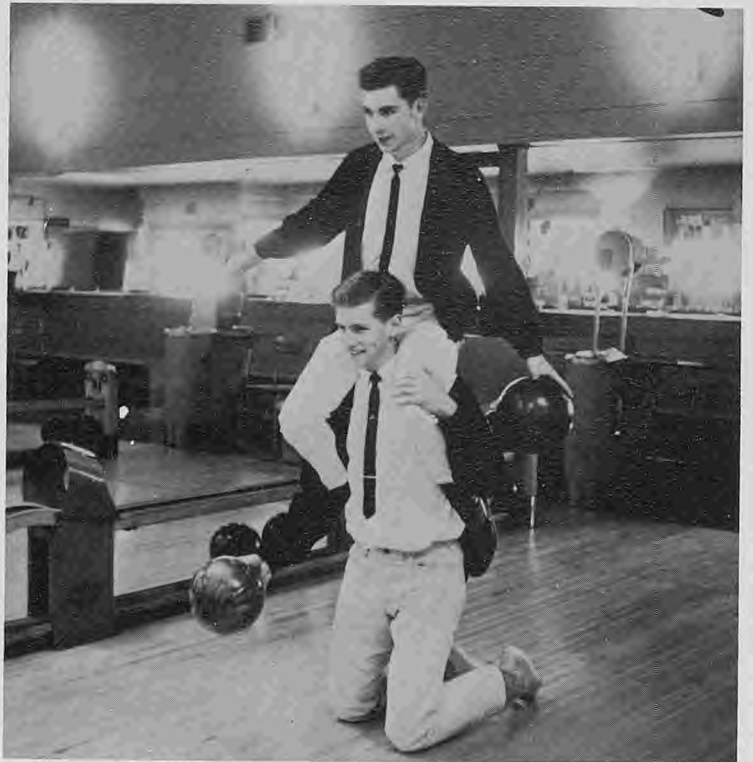
