THIS SURVEY OF THE TWO HYDESVILLE CEMETERIES WAS DONE TO PRESERVE INFORMATION ON LOCAL HISTORY THAT MAY BE LOST IN THE FUTURE. SOME OF THE HEADSTONES ARE DAMAGED, AND OTHERS SHOW VARIOUS SIGNS OF WEATHERING. IN ADDITION, OTHER HEADSTONES ARE MISSING ALTOGETHER.

GROWING UP IN ROHNERVILLE, WITH MY FATHER ERNEST CARTER HAVING BEEN BORN ON LOOP ROAD IN FORTUNA, HE RELATED MANY FINE STORIES MENTIONING VARIOUS FAMILIES IN THE AREA, AND LOCATIONS WHERE HE WORKED, FISHED, AND PLAYED. THAT SPARKED MY INTEREST IN LOCAL HISTORY.

I PERSONALLY WALKED BOTH CEMETERIES MANY TIMES, AND BELIEVE THAT I HAVE COPIED ALL THE HEADSTONES. I ALSO RELIED ON MAPS OF THE CEMETERY DISTRICT, INCLUDING SOME OLDER DISCARDED MAPS FOR INFORMATION.

HYDESVILLE

THE TOWN OF HYDESVILLE HAD ITS BEGINNINGS IN 1857-1858, AT A PLACE KNOWN AS GOOSE PRAIRIE, NEAR GOOSE LAKE, WHICH WAS TO THE NORTH OF TOWN, SO NAMED FOR THE GEESE THAT APPARENTLY WERE FOUND IN THE AREA. TYPICAL OF OTHER TOWNS OF ITS TIME, THE TOWN LATER WAS NAMED FOR ONE OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS, JOHN HYDE. A SAWMILL HAD BEEN BUILT, AND THE TOWN GREW AROUND IT. IN 1859, THE TOWN HAD A HOTEL, AND SEVERAL OTHER BUSINESSES. COOPERS MILL, LOCATED ABOUT 3 MILES EAST ON YAGER CREEK, WAS PRODUCING 25 BARRELS OF FLOUR A DAY, USING WATER POWER. BY 1861, THE TOWN HAD ITS OWN POST OFFICE, AND HOSTED THE FIRST COUNTY AGRICULTURAL FAIR. THE TOWN WAS ON THE TRAIL TO THE TRINITY MINES AND THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY. BY 1880, 300 PEOPLE LIVED IN THE COMMUNITY. FROM 1910 TO 1918, THE TOWN REVERTED BACK TO THE NAME GOOSE PRAIRIE, THEN CHANGED AGAIN BACK TO HYDESVILLE.

ON DECEMBER 13-14, 1958, HYDESVILLE CELEBRATED ITS CENTENNIAL, 1858-1958, WITH A PARADE, BARBEQUE, AND OTHER FESTIVITIES.

HYDESVILLE SITS ON A PRAIRIE ABOUT A MILE NORTH OF THE VAN DUZEN RIVER, AND SEVERAL HUNDRED FEET ABOVE THE RIVER VALLEY.

WOLVERTON GULCH IS LOCATED TO THE WEST OF THE TOWN OF HYDESVILLE ABOUT A HALF MILE. ITS CREEK FLOWS SOUTH DOWN TO THE VAN DUZEN RIVER. IT WAS NAMED FOR ALFRED WOLVERTON.

YAGER CREEK, ABOUT TWO MILES EAST OF HYDESVILLE, FLOWS TO THE SOUTH INTO THE VAN DUZEN RIVER.

VAN DUZEN RIVER, FLOWS OUT OF THE COAST RANGE, TRAVELING ALMOST DUE WEST FOR THE LAST 10 MILES BEFORE JOINING THE EEL RIVER NEAR ALTON.

CARLOTTA, ESTABLISHED AROUND 1903, IS ON THE EAST SIDE OF YAGER CREEK, ABOUT A MILE NORTH OF THE VAN DUZEN RIVER.

MCDIARMID PRAIRIE, WAS NAMED FOR FINLEY MCDIARMID, WHO WAS KILLED BY INDIANS JUST AFTER CHRISTMAS 1851. IT IS LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE VAN DUZEN WHERE IT JOINS THE EEL RIVER, THEN FOLLOWS THE EEL RIVER AROUND TO THE SOUTHEAST, THEN EAST TOWARDS RIO DELL. TODAY IT IS KNOWN AS METROPOLITAN.

CUDDEBACK, NAMED FOR HENRY BROWN CUDDEBACK, IS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE VAN DUZEN RIVER, TWO-THREE MILES EAST OF YAGER CREEK.

ALTON IS LOCATED ABOUT 3 MILES WEST OF HYDESVILLE, ON THE VAN DUZEN RIVER PLAIN, JUST BEFORE IT JOINS THE EEL RIVER.

BURNELL'S, NAMED FOR JOEL BURNELL, IS TWO MILES EAST OF ALTON, AT THE MOUTH OF WOLVERTON GULCH.

BLUFF PRAIRIE, ON THE EEL RIVER, IS SOME TEN MILES

SOUTHEAST OF HYDESVILLE. NOW KNOWN AS SHIVELY, AFTER WILLIAM BEASON SHIVELY.

ROHNERVILLE, ABOUT THREE MILES NORTHWEST OF HYDESVILLE. SLIDE, OR SPRINGVILLE IS NOW KNOWN AS FORTUNA.

EAGLE PRAIRIE, JUST UPRIVER ON THE EEL RIVER FROM McDIARMIDS PRAIRIE, ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE, IS NOW RIO DELL.

AMONG OTHER NAMES, IS BASHAW'S PRAIRIE, WHICH WAS SOMEWHERE IN THE HYDESVILLE AREA, EXACT LOCATION UNKNOWN. ALTHOUGH I AM UNSURE WHERE THEY LIVED, I NOTED THE SIMILARITY IN NAME TO GUSHAWS, WHO DID LIVE IN THE HYDESVILLE AREA. (JUST A THOUGHT)

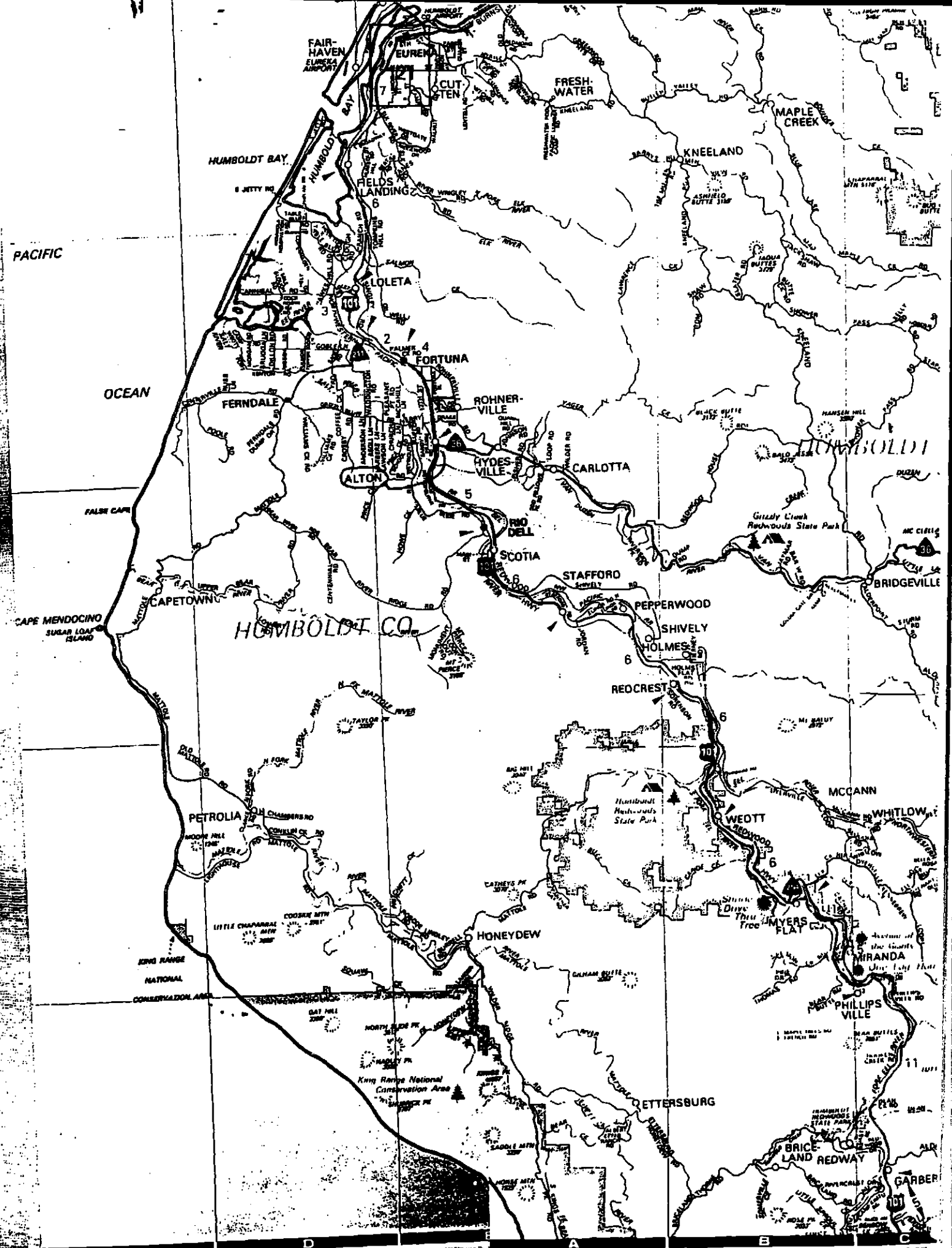

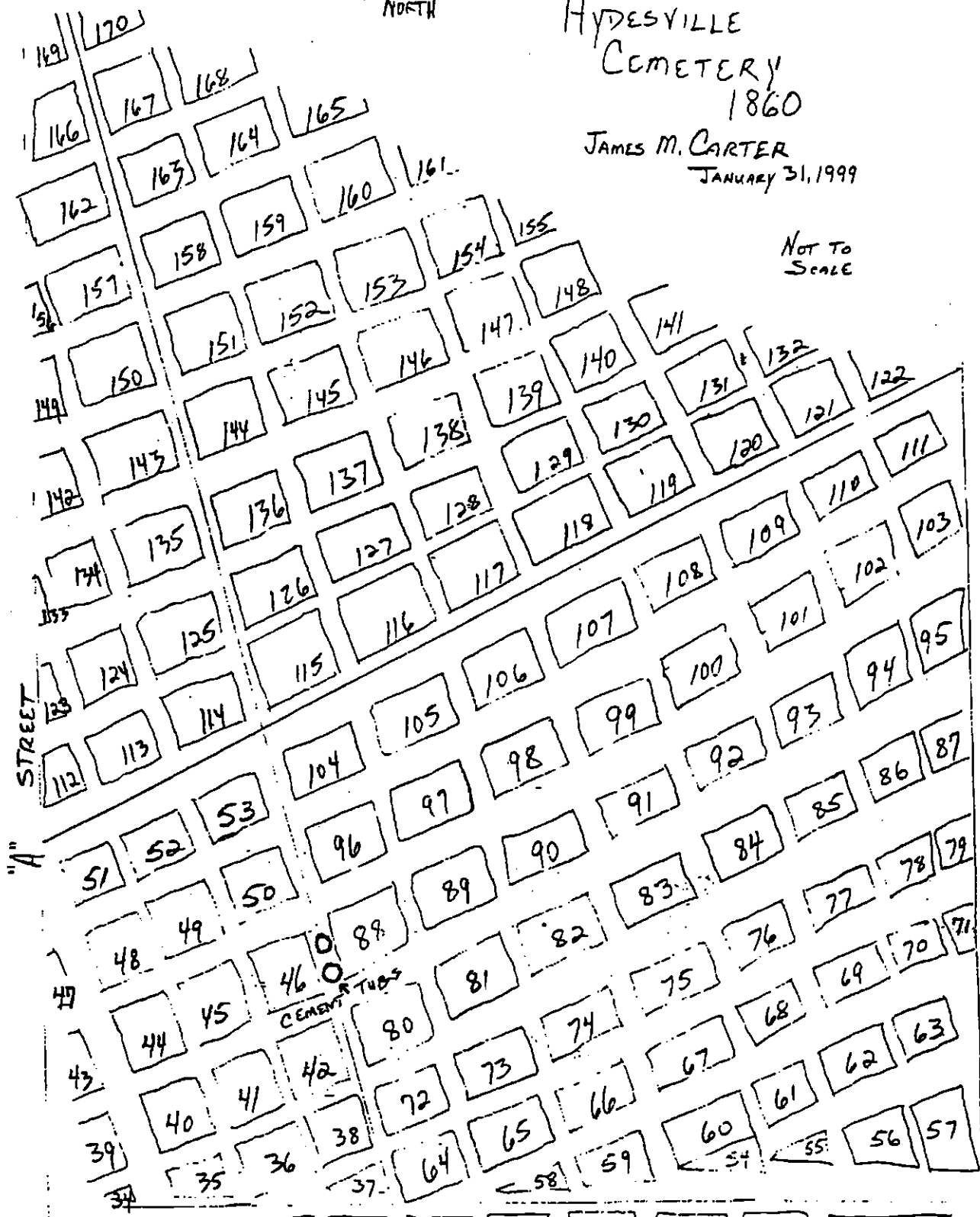
