THE NAPA VALLEY GENEALOGICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY

The Society was founded by Marian E. McGuire in July of 1974 as an offshoot of the Napa County Bicentennial Commission. There were 135 charter members by the first membership meeting in January 1975 and the Society has grown rapidly to its present status of a highly respected educational organization. Incorporation as a non-profit organization was accomplished in June of that same year.

In March 1975 the doors to our library were opened. Those using our facility found it housed in just one small room, with a few shelves of books. As our membership increased and we were financially able to purchase books (or they were donated or loaned), more space was needed, and we acquired the use of two additional rooms. Our holdings are now over 4000 volumes -- and still growing.

Instructional classes are offered in beginning genealogical research, as well as clinics for specialized help and regional study groups. Our meetings are of a very high caliber, with timely, interesting, informative topics, from which we all benefit. The Society's highly successful annual "Roots and Shoots" seminars were begun in 1978, bringing to the area the very finest genealogical teachers and lecturers.

Objectives of the Society

1. To promote interest in genealogical and related historical and biographical research.
2. To provide instruction in research techniques involving evidence, proof and documentation stressing accuracy and ethics.
3. To accumulate and preserve manuscripts, documents, records, family histories and other genealogical holdings through the establishment of a genealogical library.
4. To serve as a medium for sharing knowledge and educational and social activities.
5. To encourage compilation and publication of records, family histories and biographies.

President's Message

It has always been difficult for many genealogists to know what the current rates and regulations are for researching or ordering vital birth, death and marriage records in the various states around the country. There are books that provide this information, but many times the information is out of date by the time the book reaches the library shelf.

I have visions of genealogy societies publishing the latest rates and regulations in their quarterlies, thus keeping everyone up-to-date. With that in mind, here are those for California (as per Health & Safety Code, Section 10605), which took effect 1 January 1983.

- Birth records - \$8.00
- Death records - \$4.00
- Marriage records - \$4.00

These rates are applicable at both the state vital records office in Sacramento and in the County Recorder's office in each county. If you want the office personnel to make the search, fees are same as above, per search. If you are in California, you may go into a County Recorder's office and search all the vital records indices, all the marriage records, and many birth and death records yourself, without charge. You may not be able to see some birth and death records because they contain private information. Most offices do not allow smoking and you should not take small children with you.

When ordering vital records, if you know the county in which the event took place, you will probably get faster service ordering from the Recorder's Office in that county. If you do not know the county and the event took place after 1905, then you should send your request to the State Office of Vital Statistics, 410 N Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

The Napa County Recorder's Office now has, on microfiche, indices for the following vital records, for all of California:

- Births 1956-1979
- Deaths 1940-1981
- Brides & Grooms 1960-1981

This should be of great help to people doing California research.

Notes from the Editor

At the recent National Genealogical Society Conference held in Fort Worth, Texas, Robert M. Warner, Archivist of the United States, in an address at an assembly of the participants, made several announcements of great interest to genealogists.

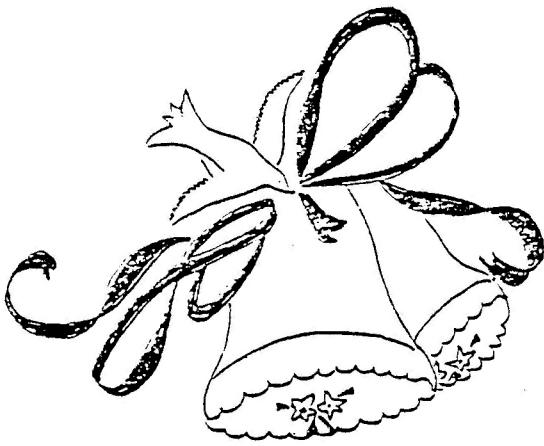
One was the publication of an updated and expanded "Guide to Genealogical Research in the National Archives." It is 320 pages long in oversized format and lavishly illustrated. The Guide covers the wealth of resources (more than 500 types of records) within the Archives, including ship passenger lists, land deeds and Civil War prison and hospital files, and often cites other repositories as secondary sources. This will be an invaluable research tool for the millions of Americans interested in the history of their families and communities.

However, there appears to be a pagination error in the cross referencing between pages and chapters. Carlton M. Smith, of Santa Rosa, California, sent corrections to the California State Genealogical Alliance, and I am passing it along here.

Cost of the Guide is \$21.00 for hardcover and \$17.00 for softcover (with a Special Handling fee of \$6.00) and can be ordered from: Genealogical Guide, Box 111, National Archives, Washington, DC 20408.

The second announcement was that the National Archives and Records Service has resumed the census microfilm program. The DDD Company has been named as contractor. As before, the program will operate only through public libraries and other institutions, such as genealogical associations. No individuals will be able to order microfilm directly from the contractor.

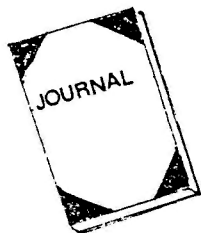

My name is William haywood Narron I am son to Thomas Narron and Sary his wife I was Bornd in the State of North Carolina Nash County in the year of our Lord 1811 December the 25 day

In the year 1827 my Father and Mother Moved to Macklinburg County North Carolina and in the year 1830 they Moved to Tennessee Bedford County.

I lived in tennessee For thirteen years. My Father and Mother Moved to illinois in 1833 and died in Bond County illinois about the year 1837

I was maried to Charlotta Williams in the year of our Lord 1834 August the 24th day at the house of Abslam Clark warren County tennessee Charlotta was Daughter to Richard Williams and Sary his wife and was Bornd in Green County tennessee in the year of our Lord 1808 July the 27th day. and Died on the 10th of June 1839. Aged Thirty years ten months and 14 days She died in Bedford County tennessee

in the year 1843 I left Bedford County Tennessee for Missouri. I left Nashville on the 22nd of May and Landed at Wellington the 3rd of June, Layfayette County Mo

William H. Narron Son to Thomas Narron & Sarah his wife Died on the 11th day of November A.D. 1865 aged 55 years 10 months and 17 days

THE MAUPINS IN VIRGINIA

The Voyage to Virginia (1700)

The Nassau was a ship of five hundred tons burden, commanded by Captain Tragian. It was a stormy passage and the voyage took from December to March. A tradition is handed down in the family that runs as follows:

....THE FISH STORY....

The Ship sprung a leak a few days off the Virginia Coast, or, as some say, was rammmed by a gigantic fish. The pumps were manned and effort made to clear the hold of water, but to no avail. Finally the crew and passengers were exhausted and quit the pumps in despair. The Rev. M. Latane and General Maupin offered up prayers to the God of the seas and of the storm. Soon the waters ceased to rise in the ship. The pumps were once more put to work and soon the ship was freed of the water. The leak was patched or boxed over on the inside and the ship made its way to the York River. At Yorktown the leak was investigated and a huge fish was found securely wedged in the broken plank. All Maupins firmly believe this tradition so reverently handed down through these hundreds of years and no matter what their religion or creed, this is one miracle that they all accept. The papers relating to the voyage of the Nassau, giving a list of her passengers, are still in existence in the Bodleian Library of England.

Individuals may order census microfilm from participating libraries and associations beginning June 5, 1983, with actual distribution of the film scheduled to begin in early July. The user may rent the film for one week (7 day) usage. Extensions are permitted if they do not interfere with the subsequent user's schedule. Because the film is now "rented" for specific periods, it must be stressed that timely customer return of the film is essential to the smooth operation of the program. The basic seven day rental for both 35mm and 16mm film (schedules and Soundex) is \$2.25, with overdue charges of \$2.25 assessed if the film is returned more than two days after the designated return date.

At the present time, the 1790 to 1900 census schedules and Soundex are available. Later this year the schedules and Soundex for the 1910 census will be available.

A person wishing to rent census microfilm can place an order through his local library or participating genealogical association. The film is then delivered to the library or the association and must be returned by them, not the individual user. Individual patrons are expected to use the film at the participating institutions. Rental film is not designed to circulate outside the institution. If film is lost or damaged beyond use, the participating institution will be charged a fee of \$12.00, which should be passed on to the patron.

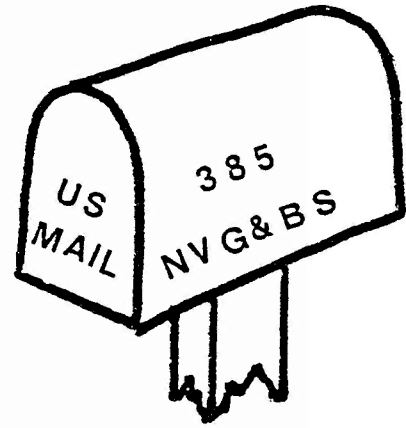
Genealogists researching in Indiana will be pleased to know that some vital statistics of that state will again be open to the public as of January 1984. Records past 75 years will be available for perusal.
