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

EDITOR'S COMMENT:

Our recently formed genealogical society is a dream that has come to pass for me. By living in the northern part of California it has been difficult for anyone to obtain any information on their family's history. The Siskiyou County Library in obtaining the census records and a microfilm reader-printer made it possible for the older families of this area to trace their family lineage. With the United States census records plus the many county records that are available, the families of this area will be able to compile or verify their family lineage accurately. By exchanging our bulletin with other libraries and genealogical societies, we may obtain the same type of information for those who are seeking to verify their ancestors in other areas. Genealogy is history. History gives little information on individual people, but it is the individual people who make history.

Since I have been doing research on Siskiyou County families. I have found some people who had no idea how many children there were in their family. This was largely due to the fact that the step parents were so good that they never made any distinction between step children and their own children. This is one of the reasons that all families should check their family history.

During my research, I have found that of the people of Siskiyou County who were early settlers all but a few came from states that had public school systems. The first public schools were started in 1834 in Pennsylvania. The rest of the New England states followed suit. About all of our early settlers were from these areas. The people who came to this area could read and write. They were also people who had trade skills.

I want to thank all those who helped to put the first issue of the Genealogical Society of Siskiyou County Bulletin together, those who compiled it, and Marvel Soule, Vada Letcher, Bernita Tickner and Wilogene Simpson for typing.

I hope in the near future to put all the family histories together.

Siskiyou County: A Brief History by Bernita L. Tickner

Searching for your ancestors in the West? If your illusive ancestor came to the gold fields, it could have been very likely to Siskiyou County that he came.

Siskiyou County was formed in 1852 by taking from Shasta and Klamath Counties. A search earlier than 1852 leads one to Shasta, Klamath and Trinity County records. In 1850, Trinity and Shasta Counties embraced the whole northern (east-to-west) section of California--from the Pacific Ocean to Nevada. Because of topographical conditions, these counties were divided. Later, Del Norte and Humboldt counties were created to share a boundary line on the southwest of Siskiyou. \*Klamath was completely abolished in 1874, having been created from the northern half of Trinity County in 1851. The same year Modoc was formed from the eastern portion of Siskiyou County.

Siskiyou County was first visited by early day trappers, to be followed by the gold miners. The population in 1852 was 2,240. The 1860's saw an increase in population with pioneering families coming to settle the valleys where abundant water and grass encouraged cattle raising to become significant.

Yreka was voted county seat in 1852, vying with Deadwood for this distinction.

\*Klamath County records were distributed between Humboldt, Siskiyou and Del Norte Counties.

## CONSTITUTION

**PURPOSE:** To stimulate public interest in family history; to collect, preserve and publish genealogical, biographical and historical matters relating to American families and places; to provide educational service to the communities in Siskiyou County, California; to establish and maintain for the use of members and others a library of American genealogy, local history and biography, including a surname file; to hold meetings for the instruction and increased effectiveness of its members; and to serve and support the genealogy departments of Siskiyou County Public Library.

### **POLICIES:**

1. This Society shall be non-profit, non-political and non-sectarian.
2. This Society is not affiliated with any other organization, but will help, share, and exchange genealogical information.

### **MEMBERSHIP:**

Section 1. Open to all individuals, libraries and societies by application for membership on a yearly basis, who are interested in promoting the purpose of the Society.

Section 2. Members joining before July 1, 1972 shall be Charter members.

Section 3. Membership in this organization shall consist of two classes: Subscribing and Active.

Section 4. Subscribing Members shall be limited to all genealogical, historical and other organizations and libraries which exchange publications for the Society Quarterly, or which subscribe to the Society Quarterly for their files at the current rate.

### **ARTICLE I - BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall consist of the five elected

officers and the appointed officers.

Section 2. A quorum shall consist of at least four Board members.

Section 3. The Board of Directors shall hold a meeting prior to the monthly meeting of the Society.

Section 4. The Board shall submit reports at the regular meetings of the Society.

Section 5. The Board shall approve any form set up by the Society.

Section 6. The Board shall appoint an Auditing Committee to audit the accounts of the Treasurer.

## ARTICLE II - OFFICERS

Section 1. The elected officers shall be a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Corresponding Secretary and Recording Secretary.

Section 2. Appointed officers shall be a Librarian, Press Chairman and Editor.

Section 3. Elected officers may also hold an appointive office.

## ARTICLE III - DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. The PRESIDENT shall preside at all meetings as Chairman of the Board of Directors; appoint officers as in Article II, Section 2; appoint committee chairmen, and serve on all committees when necessary; call special meetings of the Board of Directors; and fill vacancies in offices by appointment, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors. Either he or the Vice President shall countersign all checks with the Treasurer.

Section 2. The VICE PRESIDENT shall preside in the absence of the President; assume other duties of the President in his absence; serve as Program Chairman, and appoint other chairmen as are necessary to carry out his duties.

Section 3. The TREASURER shall have custody of all funds of the Society;

keep accurate books of account, issue membership cards; keep a record of members in good standing; shall pay out funds as authorized by the Board of Directors; shall present a statement of account at every meeting of the Society and such other items as requested by the Board of Directors; and shall make a complete financial statement for the Annual Meeting. He shall countersign all checks. The Treasurer's report shall be audited annually. Each month's Treasurer's report shall be filed for audit after each meeting.

Section 4. The CORRESPONDING SECRETARY shall receive and attend to all correspondence; shall be responsible for the mailing of notices and/or publications of the Society; shall assume the duties of the Recording Secretary in his absence.

Section 5. The RECORDING SECRETARY shall keep the minutes of all business meetings; shall read at each meeting the minutes of the previous meeting; shall keep the Constitution of the Society up to date, making all changes voted on by the membership, and shall assist the Corresponding Secretary when needed.

Section 6. An Office shall be declared vacant when the officer has been absent without adequate reason from four consecutive meetings.

Section 7. The Librarian shall be responsible for cataloging and indexing all books and periodicals acquired by the Society, and maintaining a record of accessibility.

Section 8. The Press Chairman shall represent the Society in the newspaper, radio and television publications; shall maintain a scrapbook, and prepare an annual report of the Society's activities.

Section 9. The Editor shall be responsible for the correctness of any genealogical publication that the Society undertakes.

Section 10. The Auditor shall chair a committee to audit the books annually and present the report to the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE IV - ELECTIONS

Section 1. An annual election of officers shall be held.

Section 2. The President shall appoint a Nominating Committee three months prior to the election meeting; this committee is to choose a slate of candidates to be presented two months prior to the election meeting. Nominations from the floor will be heard at the election meeting. The Nominating Committee shall serve as an Election Board to conduct the voting.

Section 3. Officers shall be elected at the regular May meeting and installed at the June meeting.

Section 4. Election shall be by ballot; however, if there is only one candidate for any office, on motion from the floor, election may be by voice vote.

Section 5. A vacancy occurring in an office shall be filled by appointment by the President, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE V - MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular meetings shall be held once each month, the last Friday night.

Section 2. Additional meetings may be held at the discretion of the Board of Directors, or at the request of 10% of the membership, upon due notice to all Active Members.

#### ARTICLE VI - DUES

Section 1. Dues shall be paid annually.

Section 2. The dues shall be \$6.00 each, or per married couple and children at the same address.

Section 3. If in arrears on dues, delinquent members will be notified

at four months, and dropped from membership rolls after six months delinquency.

#### ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENTS

Section 1. The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present at a regular meeting, providing the amendment has been proposed in writing at the previous meeting.
