IN MEMORIAM

Franklin Lee Maplesden, grandson of California Pioneers on both sides, 11th generation descendent from Gov. William Bradford of Plymouth and other early New England settlers, was born on the "Deacon" Lee homestead above the big Crystal Rock on Crystal Creek, Aug. 19th, 1918, the only child of Carrie Adelaide Lee and John Whitman Maplesden.

After graduating from the Etna Elementary and High Schools, he worked on several ranches before becoming iceman and truck driver for Mose Louthan in the Etna Meat and Ice Co., Etna. On Aug. 26, 1939 he married Mary/Ruth, daughter of the Rev. and Mrs. C. L. Goodenough, pastor of the Scott Valley Parish, in the Federated Church of Etna. Franklin's father, Whit, had helped build the Etna Methodist Church at the turn of the century and his grandfather, Elisha Mansell Lee, had helped organize the first Crystal Creek Methodist Church in the 1850s.

After the birth of their daughter, Jean Louise in 1941, he had the urge to leave Scott Valley to see some other parts of the State, so the little family moved to Lakeport, Ca. where the Goodenoughs lived. There he was employed by the Lake Laundry, but realized soon after World War II started he would need a more essential job. The family then moved to Hillsborough where he worked as a fireman in this lovely residential city adjoining Burlingame and San Mateo. Since he had been a volunteer fireman from the earliest permitted age in Etna this was a happy choice of occupations.

Fifteen months later in Aug. 1944 he was drafted into the Army when his son, James Paul, was only ten weeks old. After basic training he left the following Feb. for the Pacific Theater as a member of Cannon Co., 381st Battalion, 96th Division, where he drove an ammunition truck in the battle of Okinawa. Later the unit was sent to Mindoro Island, the Philippines for a rest before the invasion of Japan. There he drove the chaplains to various areas for their services thus getting back into church work. He was happy in the Army as long as he had a truck or other vehicle to drive; he also worked in the motor pool and narrowly escaped death when a truck slipped, pinning his head to the earth. Franklin was scheduled for promotion to Sergeant when his points became sufficient for his return to California and discharge in Feb. 1946.

He returned to the Hillsborough Fire Department where, with regular training and extra schooling he worked his way up to Lieutenant in charge of a station. He also served as secretary-treasurer of the Firemen's Welfare Fund.

The reunited family bought a home in San Mateo and helped in the founding of the Shoreview Methodist Church. In June 1955 he reluctantly resigned from the Fire Dept. because the tensions and anxiety of the job were affecting his health. At the same time his 93 year old father was requiring more care than his ailing mother was able to give, so the family returned to reside in Etna that Dec.

Never one to be out of work long, Franklin became custodian of the Etna Grammar School, a position he held until June 1967. He lost his father in Sept. 1958 and his mother in March 1965.

From Sep. 1967 until Dec. 1968 Franklin and his wife were employed at two private boarding schools near Hyampom, Trinity County. After his return to Etna he was employed by the American Building Maintenance Co. (a nation-wide business), from the Redding branch. He serviced the Bank of America and the three Pacific Telephone buildings in Yreka, nightly, until his final illness overtook him, Dec. 22, 1972.

Upon his return to Etna in 1955, Franklin rejoined the Etna Volunteer Fire Dept. and was soon driving the ambulance, for which he had been trained. The work in Trinity County and the later night work in Yreka forced him to resign from both the Fire Dept. and the Ambulance Crew.

He was also custodian of the Etna Methodist Church, a part-time job which he had also held in the Lakeport and Shoreview Methodist Churches, and which his mother had held in the Etna church for many years. He held various offices on the official board of the church, serving as usher and member of the Board of Trustees at the time of his death. He had been secretary of the Sunday School, and on the local and Shasta District Youth Camp Committee as well as the Calif-Nevada Annual Conference Camp Committee. A charter member of the Etna Methodist Men's Club, he had attended the annual convocation of Methodist Men at Mt. Hermon, Ca. early in Nov. 1972.

In addition to his church work and regular employment Franklin worked around town for the widowed and elderly doing yard work and odd jobs that needed doing, giving freely of his time and energy. It is believed that defrosting pipes in the extreme cold spell contributed to the pneumonia that took him to the Yreka Hospital Christmas morning. Finding cancer of the bone marrow was a complete surprise to all.

The high point of his life was his first airplane trip in May 1970 when he and his wife flew from Medford, Oregon to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to visit their son James and to meet Jim's wife, Carol Ann, and to become acquainted with their three months old grandson, Andrew James. While there they saw many of the historical sights of that city which will soon celebrate the 200th anniversary of the founding of our United States.

He was a member of the Siskiyou County Historical Society and the Genealogical Society of Siskiyou County and took great pride in belonging to "Keep California Green, Inc."

We have been looking over the Great Register to ascertain the nativity of the voters registered since last general election, with the following result, the total number registered after the election of 1888 being 795:

Yreka Journal--December 24, 1890--CENSUS OF YREKA AND VICINITY.

The census returns for Yreka city and township, as constituted when the census was taken last spring by Census Marshal Scofield, shows that Yreka has 1087 Population, a gain of 37 since 1880, but the Chinese population is not more than 60, a falling off of probably 75 per cent of Monogolians. On McAdams' and Indian Creeks in Yreka township, the population is 276, including about 65 Chinese, and the population of Greenhorn, Yreka Flats, and that portion of Yreka Township, from Hawkinsville precinct line to Indian Creek, foots up 1,757, and only includes Yreka city, the south end of Yreka *Basidand McAdams and Indian creeks. There is at least 300 more population in the northern portion of Yreka basin, including the town of Hawkinsville, two miles north of town, which belongs to Table Rock Township. The entire population of Yreka basin is nearly 1,800, including Yreka, Hawkinsville and Greenhorn, or about 2,100 including McAdams' and Indian creeks.

"DIED Daniel Grosse, of Cottonwood, died at Cottonwood on Wednesday. He was a much esteemed resident of this county, and a prominent member of the Masonic fraternity. His funeral took place yesterday, and was attended by several members of the Order from this city."

"DIED at the County Hospital, on the 18th, Marshman Mann, age 22 years, formerly of New York."

"MARRIED in Yreka on the 8th last, by Elder Sutton, Mr. Foote to Miss Vidilia Roberts.

"We received with the above notice a piece of delicious wedding cake. They have our good wishes for their future prosperity and happiness."

From The Mountain Herald, Yreka, Sat., Jan. 14, 1854

"FUNERAL - A large number of acquaintances attended the funeral of Lawrence Jensen of Deadwood, aged 13 years which passed through town on Saturday last towards the Yreka Cemetery. He came to his death by the accidental discharge of a pistol in his own hands while in the act of putting on a cap, the contents entering his mouth. He lingered some three weeks from the fatal wound."

From Semi-Weekly Journal, Yreka, Wed., June 11, 1862

"MARRIED at the Virginia House, June 12th, by Frances Parker, Esq., Mr. James D. McFarland to Miss Bell McCoy, all of Cottonwood. Thanks for wine etc., and cannot refrain from asserting that 'of your love we never drink too much.'"

"BOARD OF TRUSTEES - Full board present. City Sexton reported interments for past month as follows: May 14th, infant child of Mr. and Mrs. Drummond, aged 16 mos.; 23d, Chinaman; 24th, Portuguese Joe, aged 34 years; June 7th, Lawrence Jensen."
