My work on the old Yreka City
Cemetery where burials began in
the early 1850s, made me aware of
the fact there were several monu-
ments that date from this era of
history. This cemetery has so many
unmarked graves to numerous to count.
There has been burials made in all
sections, which are clearly visible.
This is the largest older cemetery
in Siskiyou Co. Some of the monu-
ments are of sandstone; others are
Vermont marble which date into the
1850s era back through the years.
I have had people tell me this was
the paupers burial ground. In reality
this burial ground is the resting
place of the pioneer citizens of
Yreka--as the monuments tell the
history.

Feb. 14, 1915, the Church voted to combine with the other Congregational Churches of Scott Valley to be known as "The Scott Valley Congregational Church".

YREKA JOURNAL Wednesday, Dec. 18, 1861

SOMETHING MYSTERIOUS--On last Friday, the leg of a man was found washed down Yreka Creek, to the rear of John Trickle's lot. The bones were well set, though the flesh was all gone, and appeared broken from the body at the hip joint. It was carefully examined by Dr. Dain, who says it belonged to a very large man, and that it was a white man. The supposition to that it came from the bank or sewer near Miner street. A mystery seems to hang over this discovery, as there is now knowledge of any person ever being buried near the creek neither are there any shafts sunk that a person might fall into.

IN MEMORIAM

Sidney Franklin Terwilliger, son of Franklin and Susan Elizabeth Hill, grandson of California pioneers, Phoebe Hogeboom and Sidney Phillip Terwilliger, was born December 16, 1891 at the Terwilliger family home located at the foot of Table Rock in Little Shasta Valley. He was one of six children, all of whom preceded him in death, except for one sister, Mrs. Clyde Turner, nee Elsie Terwilliger, of Yreka.

Mr. Terwilliger attended the Hovey Gulch Grammar School. He and his brothers and sisters rode horseback across the fields. Later he and his brother, Henry Terwilliger had a shop for repairing cars at the Webb place, now known as the Roy Townley place. They also farmed the Webb place--at first they used horses for the farming, later on they used a Caterpillar tractor. The Webb place was at one time owned by Sidney and Henry's grandfather and father.

On October 28 1928 Sidney married Miss Jessie C. Townley, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edward C. Townley at the Townley Ranch in Little Shasta. After his marriage he bought part of the Simon Newman land in the Willow Creek area where they made their home and farmed for about fifteen years.

In the fall of 1942 Sidney bought the Terwilliger Ranch at the foot of Table Rock on the Ball Mountain Road. This was the "home place" where he was born and where he continued to live until his death, February 13, 1973, age 81 years. This ranch was originally owned by his grandfather and his father. Here he raised grain, hay and Registered Polled Hereford and Commercial cattle.

He enjoyed ranch work--spending many hours in his shop, using his steel lathe and also making gun stocks. He was always available to give a helping hand to his neighbors. He particularly liked working with machinery, spending many hours adjusting and regulating it until it ran smoothly. He will be remembered as a kind and gentle man.

His memberships include the Cattleman's Association, the Greenhorn Grange and the Genealogical Society of Siskiyou County.

Mr. Terwilliger is survived by his wife, Jessie Terwilliger; a daughter, Mrs. Evelyn Hoyt of Mount Shasta; two sons, Donald of Grenada and Richard of the home ranch; a sister, Mrs. Elsie Turner of Yreka; and eight grandchildren: Werner, Teresa and Sidney Hout of Mount Shasta; Douglas, Michael and Evelyn Terwilliger of Grenada; Jennifer and Richard Terwilliger of Little Shasta.

Services were held in Girdner's Funeral Chapel, February 16, 1973. Rev. Clarence H. Freeman of the United Methodist Church officiated and burial was in the Little Shasta Cemetery.
