GENEALOGY OF THE CRARY FAMILY

Compiled by Blanche Doggett Heflin, great granddaughter of Stephen Crary and Rowena (Campbell) Crary, of Walker, Siskiyou Co., Ca.

The genealogy of the Crary family is prepared from various sources and will I hope be added to from time to time as more material is compiled. It was assembled for a family record.

Peter 1 Crary, our first ancestor, changed his Scotch name of Macquarrie to Crary. The Macquarries are an ancient clan, the chief of the Macquarries fought under Bruce at Bannockburn (1314) Changes of the name Crary, Creary, McCrary and many other versions.

Peter Crary, was named the earliest Connecticut settler bearing the name of Crary, according to all records. He had the adventurous spirit which impelled him to move from Northumberland to Plymouth, Mass, and later to go with 200 armed men to found a colony near Mystic River in New London, Conn.

Peter Crary was definitely settled in Groton, then New London, Conn., as early as April 23, 1663. He was of Scotch birth in or near Glasgow about 1645, and he came from Northumberland Co. England on the borders of Scotland. He was an ardent Cromwellian, while in England, that upon the "Restoration" 1660, he felt compelled to flee the country and some what sink his indentivity by dropping the Mac prefix.

The marriage of Peter Crary to Christobel Gallup daughter of Capt John and Hannah (Lake) Gallup, on Dec. 31, 1677, as well as the birth of their first child Christobel Crary born Feb. 1679 is found in the New London Connecticut records.

Peter Crary lived just west of upper Mystic, Conn. and died Oct. 25th, 1708 Children mentioned in his will were Christobel, Peter, Robert, Margaret, Hannah or Ann and John. All children were baptised in the Congregational Church at Stonington, Conn. William, not mentioned in the will is tho't to have died young.

Robert (2) Crary, Peter 1 baptised May 11, 1690 in Stonington, Congregational Church, married Elizabeth last name unknown. Robert's name is in the list of Freeman in Voluntown, Conn. Dec. 7th, 1727. He moved from Groton to Voluntown about 1724, where he lived until his death, which occurred in the 1750's. The children were; Christopher, William, Robert, Aaron, Benjamin, George, Oliver, Christobel and Lucy.

Capt George(3) Crary-Robert(2,) Peter(1) was born 1725/6 and married Lucy Sterry, Sept. 1756 and died Dec.19th,1760. He served in the French and Indian War with Great Britian. He was commissioned 2d Lieutenant, 1756; Lieutenant, 1757.-Taken from The Connecticut Colonial Records. March 24,1760, he was commissioned Captain of the Militia Company in a Regiment of Foot raised within this Colony to proceed and co-operate with a body of the King's British forces and under the supreme command of his Majesty's Commander-in-Chief, in America against Canada in order to reduce Montreal and all other Posts of the French in those parts and further to annoy the enemy in such manner as his Commander-in-Chief shall judge practicable, of which Regiment Eleazer Fitch is Colonel

By his Honor's command,
Thomas Fitch,

Captain General and Governor-in-Chief in and over his Majesty's English Colony of Connecticut in New England in America in the 33rd year of the Reign of his Majesty King George the second, 1760.

Within the borders of Canada Capt George Crary was taken sick with a fever contracted in the army, and was brought home to Preston, Conn. where he died, Dec. 19th, 1760, his wife and three children surviving him: Mary Robertt and George. His will is recorded in Probate Records, Norwich, Conn.

Sgt. George(4) Crary, Capt George(3) Robert(2) Peter(1) was born Sept. 19th 1760. He married Esther Brown, March 19, 1781. (Brown lineage Amos 4, Daniel 3 Thomas 2, Thomas.) Esther was born Sept

Stephen Henry Crary, (Charles(5) Sgt. George(6) Capt. George(3) Robert(2) Peter(1) Born Oct. 25, 1826, Fall River, Mass., and died Jan 26, 1915, Walker, Siskiyou County, California. He married at Voluntown, Conn. Oct. 10, 1854, Rowena Hazard Campbell, daughter of Lt. Gov. Erasmus Campbell (1858 to 1860) of Wisconsin and his wife Hannah Rodman Campbell. Rowena Hazard Campbell was born Sept. 29, 1834, Peacedale, R.I., and died May 22, 1907, at her home, Walker, Ca. Stephen and Rowena are both buried in the Evergreen Cemetery at Yreka, Siskiyou Co., Ca.

Stephen Crary was educated in the public schools of Fall River, and Newbury Mass, Providence and Newport, R.I. He taught school in Westport, Mass., and Plainfield, Conn. In March, 1850, he set out from Plainfield, on an adventure to seek gold in California, going down the Ohio River and up the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers; then he roughed it across the great American desert alone, sleeping on the ground and gazing into the starry heavens, with wolves and coyotes lending their hideous howls for the nightly serenade. At St Joseph, Mo., and almost broke with the look ahead of two thousand miles, he joined a large company of gold seekers with horses, mules and ox teams, stages six and eight horses, passengers paid \$200. each, all for the gold fields. His pack consisted of rifle, pistol, sixty pounds of crackers and two venison hams. His load was heavy and he decided to try the 'Irish Buggy' a wheelbarrow. He was known every where as the "Wheelbarrow Man". He crossed the Missouri River, May 11, 1850, with no sign of civilization, where now Kansas and Nebraska, two great common wealths have been established. For three hundred miles not a house was to be seen, but they were always within sight of the

great emigration train. On June 23, Fort Laramie was reached. Commissary stores being light, he left his buggy on the Platte River, and bought a mule from the Sioux Indians. He now had an animal to pack and ride nearly up to the South base of the Rocky Mountains. Joining a company of Missourians who had abandoned their wagon and packed their own oxen, with diminished belongings, they slowly moved forward, until Salt Lake City was reached, (July 18, 1850) with wide streets, beautiful mountains, water and fine wheatfields. He left Salt Lake City, Aug. 1, 1850, and forty two days afterwards arrived in California, about the time the State was admitted into the Union.

The winter of 1850-51, was spent in gold seeking, then he returned to the states, arriving Jan. 1, 1852, at Plainfield, Conn., the starting place.

The second trip for California began April 9, 1852, via Panama. He arrived at old Siskiyou and engaged in mining with James Alden Peabody and George L. Willey, a descendant of the Willey family that were buried in a land and rock slide in the White Mountains of New Hampshire, Aug. 1826. He again returned to the States, this time with his sister Mrs. Copeland, and Mr. Peabody, from San Francisco, by the Nicaragua route. In the autumn of 1854 he married and went to live in La Crosse, Wisconsin; where he remained for six years. He always had a longing for the Golden State, and went the third time, with his family, in May 1860; and there he resided near the same land and farm from which he dug gold in the early "fifties". Children, the last two born in Yreka:

Stephen Rodman, b. Jan. 17, 1873; unmarried.

Stephen Crary was an early day Siskiyou Co. Supervisor. He was a member of the 'Yreka Union Club' organized in 1861, to show the Patriotism for their country, the Club purchased two canons for \$100. also an elegant flag for the grand celebrating July 4th, 1861. His log cabin still stood on McKinney Creek, in the early 1930's, and the family home built about 1870, still stands on a hill, over looking the Klamath River. Rowena Crary and her daughter Blanche were both early

day teachers. Stephen, the son ran the grocery store for many years in the old family home, on McKinney Creek. Grace Crary Doggett lived with her family across the Klamath River and Rowena Crary Lange lived on Barkhouse up the Klamath River.
