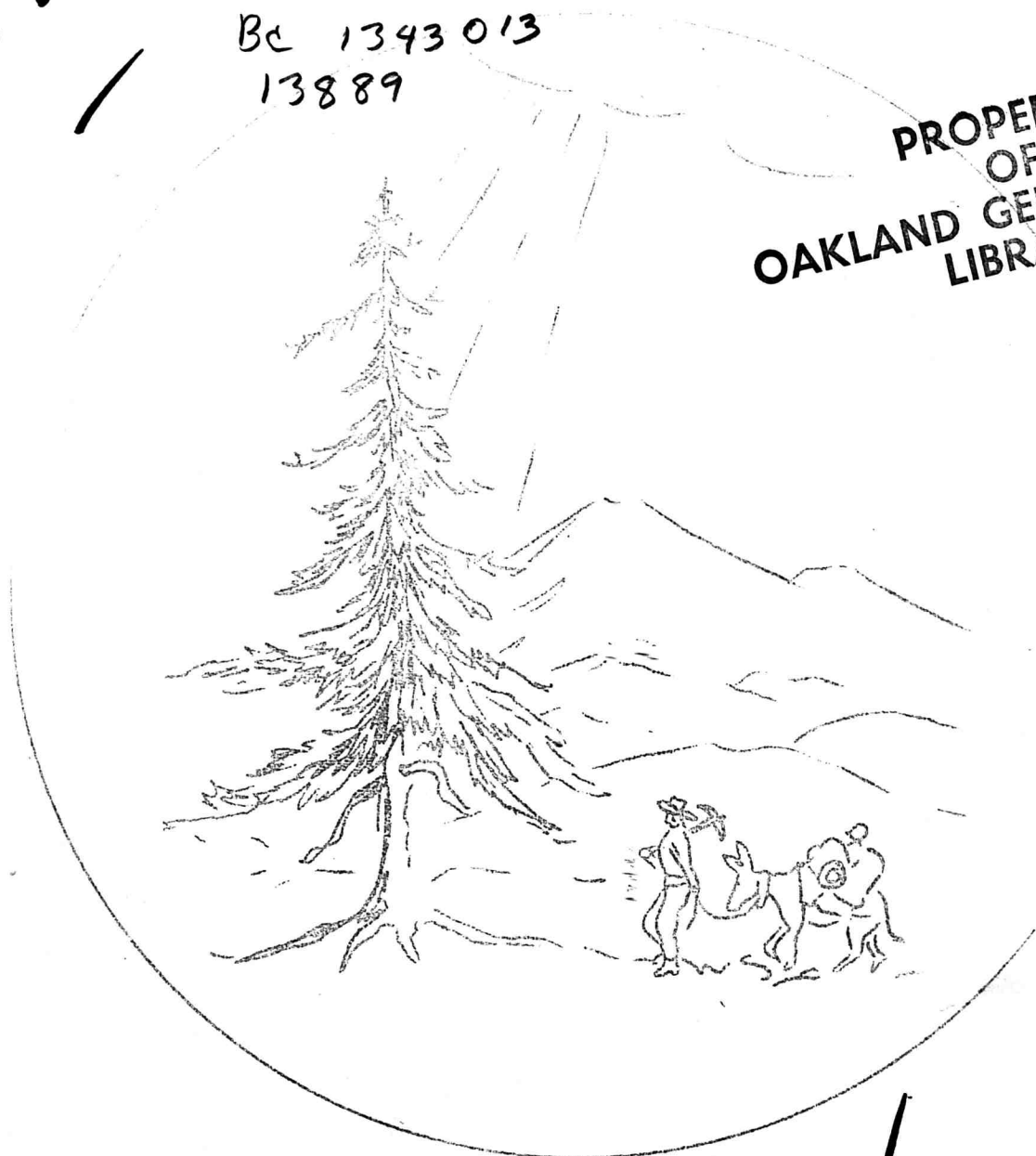

IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION

PROCEDURE

All persons who were not English, who came to New America, had to take an oath of allegiance to the Crown. 1609 to 1776. After the Revolution procedure could not be found.

1820 Congress set up an immigration department and men were naturalized through the Justice Department. No information is on a naturalization paper, except the person's name and the country they came from.

After 1918, vital stat. given, included name, country, city and county. Age, place of birth and parent's name. Later pictures were added.

Since 1953 all naturalization papers are on micro-film, and kept in Washington, D. C. No one but the original owner of a naturalization paper may obtain a copy. These papers can be copied by hand, no zerox, photos of any kind. All naturalization papers are in Washington, D. C. Information may be obtained from the Dept. of Immigration. All they will tell you is the year granted and where; then you may go to the court house, county clerks office and look at the record.

OATH OF ALLEGIANCE may be zeroxed, for otherwise they could not be printed in family pamphlets, etc.

Early voters registers gave the place of naturalization, year, etc. even if they were naturalized in another state or county. At this time when a naturalized citizen registers, they have to give the place they were naturalized. This event always takes place in a federal court. The Judge has to do this. An interesting thing, nearly all naturalized citizens are so proud of becoming a citizen, they will vote.

All children under 21 years, became citizens through their father, wives and women could not vote, so there is no record for them.

Up until 1850 on the United States Census, the man's name

was given and listed so many males and females. After 1850, every wife and child's name is on the U. S. Census; place of birth and place of parent's birth. No towns, just state of birth; the town or township, county and state are listed as of today.

Most county court houses, state capitols will photo a copy of birth, marriages, death, certificates if they have them. Also land records and deeds.

KLAMATHON DESTROYED BY FIRE

Last Friday afternoon the town of Klamathon was practically wiped off the map by fire. Only one dwelling house was left--owned and occupied by F. M. French. The depot and school house also escaped. It is said that the fire started in a vacant building where some boys were playing with matches. Fourteen residences and several barns were destroyed, only four of the dwellings being occupied by families. Most of the burned buildings were owned by W. E. Cook, who with his family was in Portland. But little of the contents were saved and the insurance was small.

As the town had been on the decline since the big saw mill and business section burned six or seven years ago, the remaining buildings would not bring much on the market, yet the loss is estimated at about \$5,000. The town will not be rebuilt.

The fire spread to the north side of the river and burned one of the buildings there. A large area of grass was burned over before the fire was extinguished.
