Mrs. Marvel Ellen Soule, editor of our Genealogical Society of Siskiyou County quarterly bulletin, and Charter Member of our society passed on unexpectedly Sunday, Feb. 16, 1975, at her home in Little Shasta.

She was born at Summit, Oregon, on April 23, 1910, and married Andrew D. "Casey" Soule¹ a member of a pioneer Little Shasta family on Sept. 6, 1930. They lived in Lewiston, Trinity County and returned to Little Shasta Valley in 1958. "Casey," an employee of the Siskiyou County Road Department, died in 1960.

Her survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Andrew (Gale Ellen) Parrino of Chicago and her children, Elizabeth Ellen and Michael Andrew "Mickey," Parrino, and a son Alan D. Soule¹ of Portland, Oregon, and his children, Beverly Lynn and Alan Dexter Soule¹ "Casey."

The citizens of the County of Siskiyou and State of California are requested to meet at the Yreka Hotel, in Yreka, on Saturday evening, the 14th of January next, at 6 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of taking measures to secure the formation, at an early day, of a new Territory out of certain portions of Northern California and Southern Oregon; and to appoint delegates to a general convention for the same purpose, to be held at Jacksonville on the 25th of January next.

NEW TERRITORY CONVENTION

The citizens of Klamath, Douglass, and Umpqua Counties are requested to hold mass meetings, for the purpose of taking into consideration the propriety of petitioning congress for the creation of a new Territory out of that portion of California lying north of the Trinity mountains. As the most appropriate means to effect such a worthy and desirable object, we would suggest to the citizens of the above counties the necessity of holding said meetings at the earliest possible period, so as to enable them to appoint ten delegates from each county, to attend a general convention at Jacksonville on the 25th of January, 1854; there (t)o express the sense of the said counties, and devise the mode and measures to consummate the same. 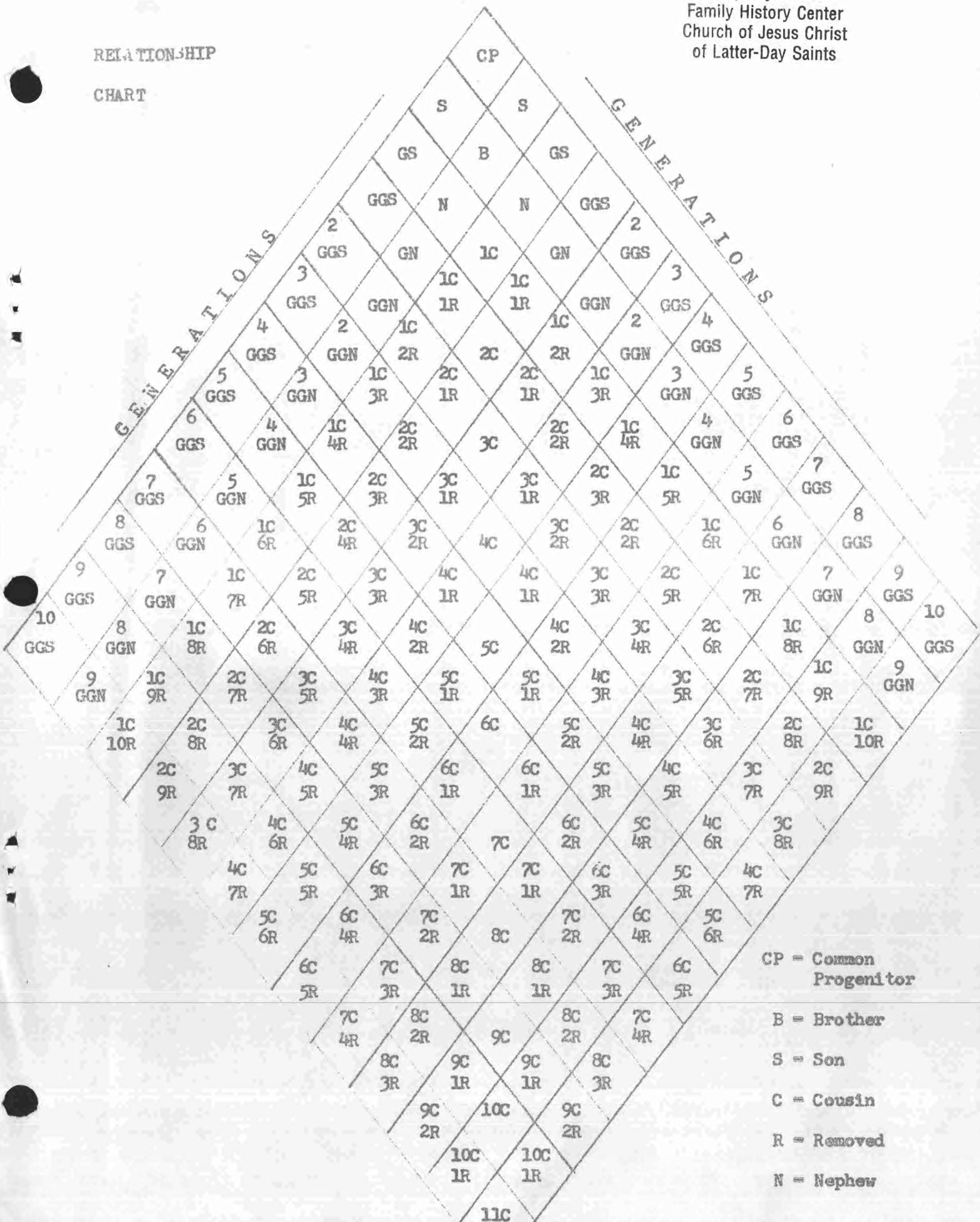
