LIBRARY AIR CONDITIONER TO BE WORKABLE BY SUMMER

A couple of paragraphs appeared under the above heading in the 8 January 1976 issue of the Independent Herald:

The Sutter County Board of Supervisors authorized sweeping authority yesterday to install a workable air conditioning system for the Sutter County Library by this summer.

Breakdowns in the \$14,175 gas fueled air conditioning system at the library on Forbes Avenue has caused the library to go without cooling many times in the summer during its five year history.

Last June, the board decided to seek recompense from the makers of the system, the Carrier Company, and yesterday, the board discussed the latest offers from the company in executive session. The Supervisors also authorized Sutter County Public Works Director Milt Skaggs to undertake the necessary action to replace the system's equipment with electrical-powered equipment in order to have the system operating before the summer months.

Skaggs said yesterday that the mechanical engineers at the Sutter County office building on Second Street in Yuba City, who examined the air conditioning, concluded that the theoretical advantage of gas over electricity had not been realized with this particular system.
